

Driver Agreement For Events Without Alcohol

- If a chapter would like to have members drive to and from an event without alcohol, they may do so, with the approval of the ATC. In addition they must follow our driver agreement.
- Every term, each member who is willing to serve as a driver for an event without alcohol must sign a driver agreement. These forms should be kept on file by the vp: social standards.
- Once the driver agreements have been collected for the term, the vp: social standards should share the list of drivers with JCMT.
- When planning an event, the event chair should have all drivers and passengers signup prior to the event on the "Delta Gamma Driver Agreement-Event Sign-Up". The event chair should verify that all drivers have signed the driver agreement.
- The "Delta Gamma Driver Agreement-Event Sign-Up" should be uploaded to e-Ops+ as part of the Post Event Summary.

- The driver must agree to abide by all federal, state, provincial and university laws.
- The driver must agree to abide by all policies and procedures of Delta Gamma Fraternity.
- The driver must agree not to consume alcohol or any controlled substance during travel, at the event or the day of the event.
- The driver must not permit consumption of alcohol or controlled substances in her vehicle.
- The driver must certify that her personal automobile liability will be covered by either her parent's (s') or her personal automobile liability insurance policy. A copy of the automobile insurance policy will be sufficient.
- If the driver is unable to drive to the event for which she has volunteered, she must notify the event chair so that alternative arrangements may be made.
- The driver must acknowledge the serious nature of her responsibility and further acknowledge that she is volunteering under her own free will, without duress or inducement of any kind.
- A member may not be required to act as a driver as a sanction resulting from a Statement of Obligation Review.
- The driver must understand that this does not take the place of approved chapter transportation for events, which are a distance from the chapter (determined by the ATC), or for those which involve alcohol.
