

Fraternity Standards for Alumnae Groups

ABBREVIATED VERSION

In accordance with the guiding principles of Article II of the Delta Gamma Constitution, "the objects of this Fraternity shall be to foster high ideals of friendship among women, to promote their educational and cultural interests, to create in them a true sense of social responsibility, and to develop in them the best qualities of character," the 12 Delta Gamma Fraternity Standards for Alumnae Groups have been established.

Using Article II as their guide, Delta Gamma alumnae groups shall meet the minimum Fraternity Standards by:

- 1. Demonstrating an understanding of and respect for Delta Gamma's larger <u>purpose and</u> <u>values</u>.
- 2. Championing <u>authentic sisterhood</u> that challenges women to become better versions of themselves.
- **3.** Executing <u>timely reporting and effective communication</u> regarding all alumnae group business and activities.
- **4.** Fostering <u>positive and collaborative relationships</u> with the larger Fraternity, local community, local alumnae, and their supporting collegiate chapters.
- 5. Welcoming all members into alumnae groups by utilizing <u>thoughtful recruitment and</u> <u>retention efforts</u>.
- 6. Encouraging members to achieve their potential through participation in <u>leadership and</u> <u>personal development</u> opportunities.
- 7. Celebrating the <u>accomplishments and milestones</u> of the Fraternity, their alumnae group, and individual group members.
- **8.** Supporting the Delta Gamma Foundation and engaging in <u>service to others</u> in the spirit of doing good.
- 9. Honoring all fiscal-related responsibilities to be in <u>financial good standing</u>.
- **10.** Performing all necessary <u>operations</u> to have a successfully functioning group.
- **11.** Fulfilling all required <u>programming</u> expectations in a thoughtful and intentional way.
- **12.** Conducting <u>officer elections and transitions and fulfilling officer responsibilities</u> to cultivate ongoing leadership within the alumnae group.
