Hope Child will invite both members and potential new members to learn more about the Delta Gamma Schools for Children with Visual Impairments through the faces and stories of their students.

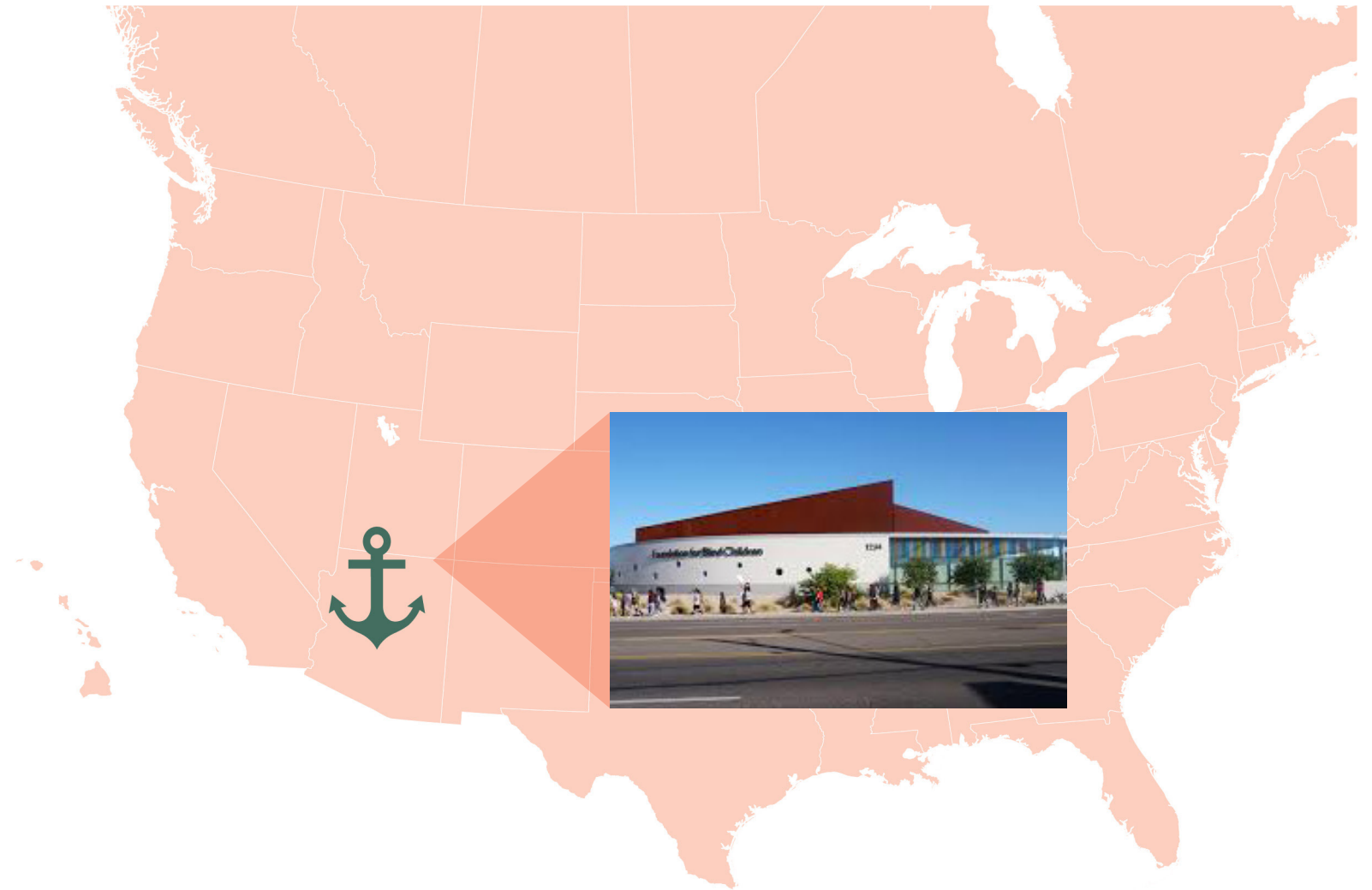
A Hope Child is another way to share the impact of the Delta Gamma Foundation and an avenue to spotlight the personal stories of Service for Sight.

Meet 7-year old Lucky, a lover of cooking and music, Lucky loves to ride the bus, jump on the trampoline, and eat out at restaurants. He also is showing a lot of interest in music and has a strong memory. Lucky was diagnosed with an extremely rare genetic disorder called Alström syndrome when he was 1 year old- this means he will have progressive vision and hearing loss, childhood obesity, and heart disease. Lucky is learning to overcome these challenges, and is most excited about using the braille at school, and has successfully learned to use a white cane, magnifier for reading, an abacus for math, and braille.
