### COLLEGIATE DIRECTOR QUICK GUIDE

# director of alumnae relations

Chapters with more than 125 members should have a director of alumnae relations, though smaller chapters may also choose to have this position. They report to the vice president: programming and serve on the joint chapter management team (JCMT). The director of alumnae relations develops a positive relationship between the chapter and local alumnae, and promotes lifetime membership. Depending on chapter size and structure, they oversee an alumnae relations committee.
