Chapters with more than 75 members should have a director of senior programming, though smaller chapters may also choose to have this position. They report to the vice president: programming and serve on the joint chapter management team (JCMT). This position plans senior recognition events.

DIVE DEEPER

- Plan an equal balance between senior recognition and senior programming. Be sure to involve the seniors year-round.
- Enlist help from your local alumnae. Reach out to your advisory team or use the chapter locator to contact alumnae to help with events.
- Utilize multi-purpose programming. Plan recognition or programming during chapter or other events, so there aren't too many meetings to attend.
