



Xcelasone Frequently Asked Questions

In accordance with our **Risk Management Philosophy**, Delta Gamma seeks to educate collegians on making empowered choices through the **Anchored in Courage** social responsibility program. Thanks to a grant from the Delta Gamma Foundation, we are launching this new health & safety education program.

What is Xcelasone?

Xcelasone is a new prevention education program created by Xcelerate Media, Inc. and developed in collaboration with NPC organizations including Kappa Kappa Gamma, Chi Omega and Delta Gamma. It is designed to be an interactive education program that empowers members to make safer, healthier and more compassionate choices.

The program consists of eight modules covering various education topics such as hazing prevention, bystander intervention, alcohol awareness, sexual assault & education and diversity, equity & inclusion.

When will Xcelasone replace GreekLifeEDU?

Xcelasone has replaced GreekLifeEDU effective immediately.

What is expected to be completed prior to Initiation?

Each new member must complete the online curriculum in its entirety. During the implementation period, all fall 2021 and spring 2022 new members will be expected to complete the program by the end of April 2022. Fall 2022 and beyond, new members will be expected to complete the Xcelasone prior to Initiation. Completion of this program makes new members eligible for initiation.

The course includes one final survey that allows you to share feedback. All survey responses are anonymous; Delta Gamma will only receive information about our organization as a whole and will not see individual members' responses.



How will officers manage progress and completion of the program? The vp: member education or director of new members will be able to easily monitor progress and completion via Anchorbase Member Education Reports.

How will new members access the program? New members will log into the program with the same member email and password used to access their Delta Gamma member account. Thus, new members must claim their Delta Gamma accounts first in order to access the program.
