Joining a Zoom Meeting

× Via URL

- 1. Click the Meeting URL provided by the host.
 - Follow the prompts to download and install the **Zoom desktop application**. You will need to download the app to use meeting chat and participate in polls.
 - You will see a pop-up to **enter your email address and your name**. Please note that whatever you enter here for your name will be displayed to all participants.
 - You can change your screen name at any point by hovering your mouse over your name on your Zoom video and clicking the **Rename** button that appears.

Note: If you click the Meeting URL too early, you will see a "waiting" message appear on your screen and you will automatically join the meeting when it begins.

Hide Self-View

Tired of seeing yourself on screen all day? Here is how to hide yourself from your screen, while allowing others to still see your video.

Locate your video.

- 2. Right-click your video to display the menu shown here, then click "Hide Myself".
- You will no longer see the video of yourself, even though others in the meeting will be able to see a video of you (if your video is turned on).

Note: To restore the video of yourself, right-click any visible user's display to show the menu. Then, select **"Show Myself"**.

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Chat Box Tips

How do I send a message to the host/facilitator rather than to everyone?

- When looking at the Zoom Group Chat, click the blue circle around "Everyone" to prompt a dropdown menu.
- 2. Click "Panelists" to send a message just to the meeting host and facilitator team.

Note: You can use this same method to select an individual attendee to send a private message. Be sure to check this box to make sure you are sending the message to the correct person before you send!



Speaker View vs. Gallery View

How do I focus my screen on just the speaker, rather than little boxes of everyone attending?

 Click the "Gallery View" or "Speaker View Button" on the top right corner to toggle between each type of screen view. Gallery view may be best when you are in breakout spaces or networking sessions. Click here to make that switch.











How do you restore your Zoom screen if you've been spending time on a different computer program while Zoom runs in the background?

- 1. Find the thumbnail Zoom screen on your desktop, shown here.
- Click on the button shown here to exit minimized video and return to the larger meeting view.

Note: If you have lost the Zoom meeting, you can return to the meeting by clicking the **Zoom** icon, then **Back to Meeting**.
