director of new members

Chapters with more than 35 members should have a director of new members, though smaller chapters may also choose to have this position. They report to the vice president: member education and serve on the joint chapter management team (JCMT) and the Retention Committee.. The director of new members implements the New Member Pursuit program and prepares new members for full membership in Delta Gamma. Depending on chapter size and structure, they oversee a new member committee.
