When do I no longer owe per capita dues?

Those who have been members of Delta Gamma for 50 years or are participants in our Loyally Anchored lifetime dues program are no longer asked to pay annual alumnae per capita dues. Length of membership is calculated from a member's Initiation date, not their pledge date or graduation date.

Are there local alumnae group dues?

What happens if I don't pay my per capita dues?

Alumnae are asked to pay per capita dues each fiscal year until they reach 50 years of membership. However, we understand that sometimes a member forgets to pay or enters into a season of life that prevents her from paying dues. Members do not lose alumnae standing in Delta Gamma if they do not pay dues, and we do not require alumnae to pay back dues they may have missed, but we do encourage members to begin paying again as they are able.

I paid my dues, but I still received an email or mailing. Did you receive my payment?

If you have paid your dues in the last few weeks, please disregard the dues communication you recently received. Oftentimes distribution lists are created while dues payments are being processed, and members who have recently paid still receive the reminder to pay. If your member profile shows that you are paid through the end of the current fiscal year, then we have your payment!
